

Student Responsibilities in Regards to Safeguarding Under 18s

Wherever reasonably possible, The Leeds School of English will endeavour to place all students in age appropriate groups (-14; 14-18; 18+). However, smaller numbers of students aged under 18 enrolling with the School may prohibit an under 18 group formed, especially if their levels of English are different. Therefore, you may find students within your group who are under the age of 18.

We do not want you to treat the under 18s any differently from the other students in your class, but we would like you to be aware and think about what you discuss with them and how you interact with them. Please consider what is appropriate – and what is not.

Where there are mixed age groups, the first point of responsibility for safeguarding the under 18s in your group is your teacher, who may let you know if they believe that something you say or do is inappropriate for under 18s. If you continue with your inappropriate behaviour, then your teacher will refer you to the Academic Manager. This may result in a disciplinary procedure.



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
