



Admission Policy

The Leeds School of English is committed to valuing diversity. In accordance with our Diversity and Equal Opportunities Policy, we welcome applicants from all sections of the community.

Admission

Admission to the School is subject to completing an application procedure as set out in the School's Terms and Conditions, and meeting the entry requirements for the levels and courses that the School can offer.

Decisions to offer a place, or to reject an application, are based entirely on academic grounds. The final decision made has to be confirmed by the Academic Manager, who may request a review of an academic decision if they feel that the School's criteria for a course offer has not been applied rigorously or if they believe there may be extenuating circumstances to justify waiving the normal entry requirements.

Before a final decision is taken to make an offer to an applicant, consideration is then given to any disabilities or learning support needs so that the School can be assured it has the capacity to provide all necessary support and assistance. This may require the School to contact the applicant directly to ensure that they are fully aware of what arrangements can be made. Full consideration is also given to any safeguarding issues.

Any offer made in good faith later discovered to have been based on fraudulent or false information will be automatically cancelled.
